

Terminal Services & Avimark Printer Setup

AVIMARK®

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The Avimark Site feature will only work with (TCP/IP) network ready printers or (TCP/IP) network print servers. The only recommended print servers at this time are HP JetDirect en1700 for use with USB printers and HP JetDirect 170X or 300X for connecting parallel printers.

- 1. Start and log on to a local workstation.
- 2. Set up printers/print servers on local workstations per manufacturer's instructions. Please contact the manufacturer for assistance.
- 3. Test print from Windows to verify printer/print server operation.
- 4. Share printers. Note the share name and workstation name for later use.
- **5.** Establish a VPN connection between the remote workstation and the Terminal Server. Please contact Microsoft or your local Network Technician for assistance.
- 6. From the local workstation, log in to Terminal Server with a workstation unique username.
- 7. Setup as a network printer, connect to this printer, \\remoteworkstationname\\printer_sharename.

 Test print from the Terminal Server to verify printer/print server operation.



Avimark does not provide support for the preceding steps. Please consult your local technician and/or Microsoft for assistance. If the Terminal Server cannot print a Windows test page to the remote site's printers, Avimark will not print.

- 1. Start Avimark from the Terminal Server desktop.
- 2. Set up printers in Avimark: Utilities > Printer Setup.
- 3. Test printers in Avimark.
- 4. Repeat the steps for each remote location workstation.
